NHMEA All-State Auditions

Registration Deadline: December 4, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

Audition Window: November 28 – December 4, 2020 at 11:59 p.m.

Festival Dates: April 15-17, 2021 (Festival format to be announced in mid-December)

General Information:

1. The fee for auditions is \$20.00 per audition. Students and schools are encouraged to pay by credit card when possible. This year only, students may pay their registration fee individually. Schools sending checks should try to send only one check to NHMEA, PO Box 717, Stratham, NH 03885. Payment must be postmarked by December 4, 2020.
2. All registration information is submitted directly through the OPUS EVENT system by your school's director. Submission of this application form serves as an acknowledgement of the rules regarding this event. Directors are encouraged to keep a copy of this form signed by parents/students on file. A PDF copy of this information is available on the All State Festival page at nhmea.org.
3. Students auditioning on more than one instrument/voice part should indicate to their director their preference if accepted to more than one ensemble prior to director submitting registration.
4. If selected for the festival, students are expected to participate. Further details regarding the format of the festival will be announced by mid-December.

Eligibility:

1. You must be a member in good standing of your school's performing group, if one exists. Due to the unusual circumstances surrounding this year's event, NHMEA understands directors may need to be flexible with this policy.
2. Homeschooled students must follow the NHMEA policy regarding Home Education Students in NHMEA Festivals. Please contact the auditions chairperson with any questions.
3. Your school district must pay the NHMEA School Participation Fee by October 1.
4. Individuals paying for their audition fee must pay in full before submission of audition materials. Schools paying by check must postmark their payment or send a purchase order by December 4, 2020.
5. If auditioning and/or selected as an All-State participant, your school music teacher must accompany you to the All-State Music Festival as your chaperone should an in-person event take place this year.
6. If selected as an All-State participant, the director and student will abide by all participation guidelines and policies while at the festival.
7. Any appeals to the eligibility criteria must be submitted in writing to the All State Auditions Chairperson and the NHMEA President fifteen days before the registration deadline for consideration.
